

KITTEN CARE 101: FEEDING YOUR KITTEN



What should I feed my kitten?

Choosing the right diet is a vital step to making sure your growing kitten is meeting their nutritional needs. Remember that cats are obligate carnivores--they depend entirely on meat because their diet requires nutrients that are only found in animal flesh.

Here is a short list of some diets that we recommend that have met (or exceeded) AAFCO standards and are specifically tested and formulated for cats under a year of age.

KITTEN (<1)

HILLS

- Science Diet: Indoor Kitten (wet/dry)

PURINA

- One: Healthy Kitten Formula (dry)
- One Focus: Kitten Formula (wet)

NUTRO

- Wholesome Essentials: Kitten Food (dry)
- Wholesome Essentials: Max Kitten (wet)

IAMS

- Proactive Health: Healthy Kitten (dry)
- Proactive Health: Healthy Kitten (wet)

There should be a chart suggesting amounts to feed per given body weight, in number of cups or ounces per day, on every bag of food.
